Hazem Al-Zubi is a Jordanian sculptor and ceramicist. He graduated from the Academy of Fine Arts in Baghdad in 1982, served as President of the Jordanian Association of Fine Artists, and taught for more than a decade at the University of Jordan. He has exhibited in Amman, Beirut, Damascus, Doha, Dubai and Washington, and at the Sharjah and Cairo biennials. He received the UNESCO Prize for Art and Creativity in 1994 and the Jordanian State Appreciation Award in 2004. Two permanent halls are dedicated to his work in Amman.
